Ten Step Plan for Safer Road Infrastructure

- **30 months project** (Oct'20-Mar'23) funded by the United Nations Road Safety Fund (**UNRSF**) & co-financed by the Global Road Safety Facility (**GRSF**) thanks to funding from UKaid.



- Implemented by **UNECA**, in partnership with **IRF**, **iRAP**, **PIARC** and **TARA**.
- **Objective:** To reduce traffic fatalities and injuries in Tanzania by building the **institutional capacity** to improve **road infrastructure safety** and to pilot the approach with **concrete action on planned and/or on-going road projects**.




Delivering on Target 3 and 4

TARGET **3**
2030



Target 3: By 2030, all new roads achieve technical standards for all road users that take into account road safety, or meet a three star rating or better.

TARGET **4**
2030



Target 4: By 2030, more than 75% of travel on existing roads is on roads that meet technical standards for all road users that take into account road safety.

Key Project Milestones

- Reviewed and updated National Road infrastructure Safety Strategy and Action Plan – ongoing
- Reviewed and updated National Road Design Standards/Guidelines, to ensure that they address road safety for all road users – ongoing
- Establishment of National Road Assessment Programme (TanRAP) - completed
- Establishment of a new National Training, Accreditation and Certification Scheme – ongoing
- A minimum of 100 local stakeholders trained (e.g. RSA, iRAP) – completed
- Star rating of designs, road assessments – ongoing

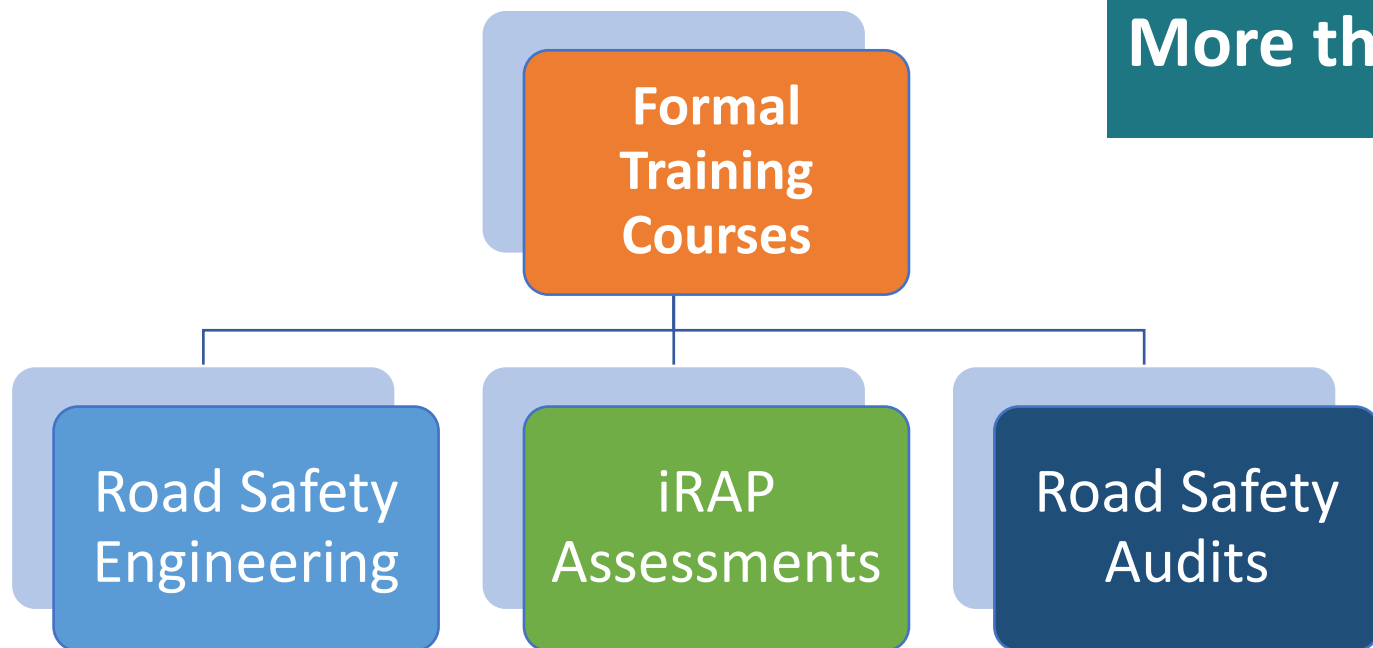
