TECHNICAL VISITS

18 October 2024

Eurasia Tunnel

The first road tunnel connecting the Asian and European continents underneath the seabed. The whole route stretching between Kazlıçeşme and Göztepe, including the tunnel approach road, has a length of 14.6 km, while the double-deck tunnel itself is 5.4 km. The tunnel was built beneath the seabed by using a special technology. Due to the new crossing, the travel time between the two continents, which took before more than one and a half hour, it now takes only 5 minutes.





Yavuz Sultan Selim Bridge & Northern Marmara Motorway

The longest suspension bridge in the world with a rail system and the widest suspension bridge in the world.

We have connected the Asian and European continents for the 3rd time, the 1st time by railway. With its main span of 1,408 m, the Yavuz Sultan Selim Bridge, the longest bridge in the world to accommodate a railway system, has a total length of 2,164 m, including its side openings. Designed as a combination of a suspension bridge and a cable-stayed bridge, is a unique and striking example within its category due to its hybrid design. Northern Marmara Motorway and the Yavuz Sultan Selim Bridge, which are prestigious projects in every aspect, are symbolic projects of Türkiye with their modern, aesthetic, advanced materials, and engineering techniques.



TECHNICAL VISITS


The Istanbul-Izmir Motorway

Constructed using the Build-Operate-Transfer financing model.

The Osmangazi Bridge forms the most important section of the Istanbul-Izmir Highway, which has a total length of 426 kilometers, including 384 kilometers of the highway and 42 kilometers of connecting roads. The highway route has been moved outside the RAMSAR Conservation Area, reducing the negative impact on biodiversity. This highway is particularly known for the interventions made to safeguard birds and other animal habitats and plant species in the region.

1915 Çanakkale Bridge Malkara-Canakkale Motorway

The 1915 Çanakkale Bridge provides a crossing over the Strait of the Dardannelles as part of the 101 km-long Malkara-Çanakkale Motorway. The 1915 Çanakkale Bridge forms the most crucial crossing point of the Kınalı-Tekirdağ-Çanakkale-Savaştepe Motorway, which completes the Marmara Motorway Ring. With the 1915 Canakkale Bridge providing uninterrupted road access across the Strait of Dardanelles, the crossing time has been reduced to 6 minutes. This marks the 1st time in history that a continuous motorway connection has been established across the Strait.


